Information:

1. Be prepared. Pack using the gear checklist in your Scout Handbook (10 Essentials).

Additional required summer camp items:

- Class A and Class B Scout Uniforms.
- Spending money for lunch (X2), treats at camp, and souvenirs at the Trading Post.
- Merit Badge Blue Cards, completed prerequisites, money if required.
- Completed medical forms current through the event.
- Rain protection and change of shoes to include hiking footwear.
- Camping clothing for a week to include cold weather gear.
- Sleeping bag and pillow.
- Toiletries to include towel, shower shoes/sandals.

Optional summer camp items:

- Fishing pole and tackle.
- Swimsuit, water shoes, beach towel, and sunglasses.

2. Cost: \$300 per scout, \$220 per adult. Non-refundable payment of \$100.00 per participant due NLT 7 May. Second payment of \$100.00 due NLT 20 May, final payment of \$100 due NLT 3 June. Brother discount available (\$25 dollars off for each brother). *This is a “non-refundable” event*****

3. Merit badge interest survey due NLT Monday 6 March

4. Swim pre-test at Camp Pendleton 13 Area Pool on Monday, 4 June at 1800. Pizza and drinks will be provided!

5. Bring medical forms A, B, C NLT 4 June.

6. Bring your event permission slip NLT 4 June.

7. Meet at the Scout Hut in Class A uniform at 0530 on Sunday. We will depart at 0600 so be on time. Plan on arrival at Scout Hut Saturday afternoon around 1400.
